Mobile Black Spot Program: Improved mobile service to regions

The Mobile Black Spot Program (MBSP) has in seven rounds of funding invested more than \$1 billion to deliver up to 1,400 new mobile base stations across Australia, as a Government initiative to invest in telecommunications infrastructure to improve mobile coverage and competition across Australia.

٠

The combined grant opportunity for Round 7 of the MBSP and <u>Round 3 of the Regional Connectivity Program</u> (RCP) distributed \$170.2 million (GST inclusive) in funding awarded for a total of 136 mobile and broadband solutions across Australia.

The MBSP is supported by co-contributions from state and local governments, national Mobile Network Operators (<u>Optus</u>, <u>Telstra</u>, <u>TPG Telecom Ltd (formerly Vodafone)</u>, and Mobile Network Infrastructure Providers (<u>Field Solutions Group</u> and <u>OneWiFi</u>). Funding from this round included:

- \circ \$41.3 million to deliver 43 new base stations across Australia; and
- \$13.6 million will be provided for 19 new base stations located in First Nations communities.
- 25 new OneWiFi neutral host base stations that will support multi-carrier outcomes.
